Arabic Language Curricula

#### 1. Al-lisan Series:

The Al-lisan Series has been complied and developed by our qualified native Arabic tutors under the supervision of senior professors in the Arabic language. The series covers all the aspects and elements of the language such as speaking, reading and writing in addition to some practical grammatical rules. These topics also meet all the requirements that the learner needs and comprehensively cover the topics handled. Topics have been chosen according to the Dewey Decimal System in the division of human knowledge topics.

#### Levels of the Al-lisan Series:

The Mother Tongue Center has employed the CEFR Scale in dividing the levels of teaching Arabic as a second language into 4 levels. These levels are as follows:

- 1- Al-Kitab Al-Tamhidi (2 volumes and an exercise book).
- 2- Al-Kitab Al-Mubtadea
- 3- Al-Kitab Al-Mutawasset
- 4- Al-Kitab Al-Mutagaddem

## Objectives of the Al-lisan series:

Achieving basic proficiency in the following linguistic skills:

- 1- The ability to fully understand Arabic conversations or audio materials.
- 2- Facilitates perfect understanding of written material.
- 3- Enables fluent conversation and self-expression.
- 4- The ability to write words, sentences and essays.

Achieving basic proficiency in applying the following linguistic elements:

- 1- Arabic sounds, characteristics of letters and solving pronunciation problems
- 2- The vocabulary and expressions related to topics used in the everyday life.
- 3- Sound grammatical structures.
- 4- Achieving basic proficiency in communicating with Arabic speakers.
- 5- Achieving cultural proficiency in communicating with Arabic speakers.

2. AX-Bayan Series:

The Mother Tongue Center is currently working on the compilation and development of Al-Bayan Series in teaching Arabic as a second language commensurate with the spirit of the age and the vocabulary and syntax needed to understand the Islamic culture and the intellectual necessities in Islam.

This makes the non-Arabic-speaking Muslim student, who is interested in Islamic vocabulary, ideas and culture, grasp the context and the content of the Islamic culture.

This series comprises eight volumes with 600 class hours. It is divided into four levels (beginner, pre-intermediate, intermediate and advanced). A tutor's guide and an exercise book come along with the series.

Arabic Language Learning:

The Mother Tongue Center teaches Arabic to non-native speakers at all levels using the experience of its tutors and the Alkitab, Al-Tamhidi and Al-lisan series in teaching Arabic to non-native speakers

The Mother Tongue Center adopts the ILR and the CEFR scales in dividing the teaching of a second language into 4 levels. These levels are also subdivided into smaller courses to provide greater flexibility. The course levels cover various topics of human knowledge in line with the Dewey Decimal System of dividing human knowledge topics.

Considering the long working hours and the busy schedules for most of students enrolled in our courses, The Mother Tongue Center offers flexible programs in terms of content and schedules. There are also programs designed for full-time students so that they can progress faster in their learning, while preserving the high quality of education received.
